26		were presented by Lucent. At Lucent's request, the following text from the contribution
27		is noted in this meeting summary: "Since our Ballot Comments have either been
28		addressed or withdrawn and in the interest of meeting the ITU-R deadlines, Lucent will
29		change its vote for IS-2000.2, .3, and .5 from "No" to "Yes." However, we would like
30		to note that the process followed for the standardization of cdma2000 Release C may
31		have been compromised. In many cases instead of building consensus, the Working
32 33		Groups and even Sub-Working Groups were required to resort to voting processes to resolve issues. These voting processes were determined on a Working Group basis
34		with no formal guidance. In the case of Ballot Comment resolution, several comments
35		were never given due process in view of meeting the deadlines. In some cases, ballot
36		comments were discussed only a few days prior to the final votes to determine their
37		disposition, or even on the same day as the vote occurred. In many cases, companies
38		were not provided time to bring responses to technical issues prior to the voting

procedures." This contribution was noted as FYI for the TSG.
