**Opening Plenary:**

Draft correspondence to TSG-S regarding work item integration between TSG-N and All IP Ad Hoc work sheets was distributed for review.

Draft correspondence to TSG-S in response to a TSG-S correspondence on Secure Mode OTA was distributed for review. Based on discussion of this draft, an ad hoc session was arranged for Tues. over lunch to raise questions to the PMT regarding the 3GPP2 work item progression process.

Draft correspondence to TSG-S regarding worksheets distributed for review was distributed for review.

Discussion of a TSG-S correspondence on RC-PDSIT led to an assignment for B. Kidwell, C. Ishman, and C. Fitzpatrick to prepare a response to TSG-S with proposed modifications to the RC-PDSIT Stage 1.

Draft correspondence to TSG-S regarding the 3GPP2 work item progression process was distributed for review. This was remanded to the ad hoc meeting over lunch Tues.

Correspondence from the All IP Ad Hoc regarding the use of the term WNO was deferred to Tucson.

Draft correspondence to TSG-C regarding their request to add 3 teleservice IDs to TIA/EIA-41-E was distributed for review.

Draft correspondence to TSG-P requesting review comments on PN-4720 was distributed for review. It was suggested to send this to all TSGs, not just TSG-P.

Draft report to SC was distributed for review. An ad hoc group was formed to meet Tues. evening to prepare a TSG-N position on the inclusion of regulatory requirements in TSG-N documents.

Correspondence from IFAST requesting input on international roaming was distributed for review. D. Crowe took an assignment to modify the TR-45.2 report to include TSG-N as well. D. Crowe offered to act as liaison for all of 3GPP2, providing input is sent from the other TSGs. B. Kidwell took an assignment to draft correspondence to the other chairs with this liaison offer.

Correspondence from the All IP Ad Hoc regarding a first IP release plan was deferred to Tucson. Members noted the situation may change pending a decision by TSG-A.
