

APPROVED MEETING REPORT 3GPP2 Organizational Partners Meeting #24 ARIB/CCSA/TIA/TTA/TTC October 7, 2003 Via Teleconference

1. Opening

The meeting was opened at 8:05pm by Cheryl Blum, TIA Head of Delegation

2 Attendance

The Secretary noted those present on the call. Contribution OP-20031007-002, providing a list of delegates for the meeting was prepared and posted.

3. Approval of the agenda

 The Chair introduced the agenda for the meeting contained in contribution **OP-20031007-001r1** and asked if there were any changes or edits. It was noted that the PMT has been reviewing the output provided by the OPs regarding the proposed 3GPP2 publications process, and that a number of agreed-upon modifications have been made to the material. It was requested that an additional agenda item be accommodated to introduce this new material. There was no objection to inserting new agenda item 7.2: Publications Process Update.

The revised agenda (OP-20031007-001r2) was approved.

4. Contribution Assignments and Status

The Chair introduced contribution **OP-20031007-000r1** consisting of the list of contributions for the meeting. No additional contributions were noted.

5. Approval of previous meeting summary

The summary of the previous meeting held on September 15 2003, as presented in contribution **OP-20031007-003**, was approved as presented.

16			advocating TSG input in a manner similar to the way TSGs provide work		
17			plan inputs currently. The OPs noted the criteria offered by ARIB/TTC		
18			for defining critical path items. The Chair invited the CDG to comment		
19			on the role it might play in this arena.		
20					
21			Mr. Sam Samra noted that the CDG is currently working with 3GPP2 via		
22			the activities of the CDG Evolution Team. The CDG also offered to assist		
23			by polling operators, not all of which participate in 3GPP2, to prioritize		
24			any items deemed critical.		
25					
26			The Chair opened the floor for comments. The following points were		
27 28			made:		
29			The list of the four criteria for determining critical path items		
30			presented in the ARIB/TTC contribution OP-200310007-008 and		
31			the list of two items presented in the TIA contribution OP -		
32			200310007-007 would be combined. Further, it would be noted		
33			that the consensus process already implemented by 3GPP2 would		
34			be used to determine the higher-priority items of the organization.		
35			These items would primarily be discussed in the PMT, be		
36			delivered to TSG-S for review and approval, and ultimately		
37			delivered to the Steering Committee where the final determination		
38			would be made.

40			• It was clarified that the process for determining the critical path		
41			items would be iterative, either via the distribution of a revised		
42 43			release plan to TSGs for further comment, or via a dedicated		
43 44			meeting of the PMT, or via other means as deemed appropriate.		
45			Noting a general acceptance with the inputs provided by the OPs, the		
46			Chair recommended that the inputs be consolidated into a single

The Chair 5 asked if there was any objection to approving the footnote text contained 6 in contribution **OP-20031007-004B**. No objection was raised. 7 8 **DECISION 2003/10-01** 9 The Organizational Partners approve the text proposed by ARIB/TTC in 10 contribution OP-20031007-004B as the text to be applied to 3GPP2 11 documents to denote the trademark status of the term cdma2000. 12 13 It was noted that the Secretariat would prepare correspondence to the 14 TSGs noting the approved usage and would review output documents 15 published since the date of registration in the USA to amend any existing 16 footnotes with the newly-approved text. 17 18 **ACTION 2003/10-02** 19 The Secretary is to draft correspondence to the 3GPP2 membership via the 20 TSGs noting the approved method in which the trademark status of the 21 term cdma2000 is to be noted in 3GPP2 documents. 22 23 **ACTION 2003/10-03** 24 The Secretariat is to amend 3GPP2 documents published since registration 25 of the term cdma2000 as a trademark in the USA by replacing any existing 26 footnote text with the newly-approved footnote, and is to return the 27 amended source-file to the editor for future maintenance. 28 29 7.2 Publications Process - Update 30 31 It was noted that the input provided by the Organizational Partners 32 outlining the proposed 3GPP2 publications process had been slightly 33 altered by the PMT in an effort to provide greater clarity of the process to 34 the membership. A table, providing a record of the modifications made, 35 has been prepared. It was requested that this table, and the resulting 36 revised publications process guidelines, be reviewed by the Organizational 37 Partners to ensure OP approval of the modifications made by the PMT. 38 This proposal was supported by the Organizational Partners. 39 40 **ACTION 2003/10-04** 41 The Secretariat is to distribute, to the OPs, the material prepared by the 42 PMT noting the modifications made to the input provided by the 43 Organizational Partners relative to the revised 3GPP2 publications 44 process. The Organizational Partners are asked to review the material and 45 to provide any comments in preparation for the October meeting of the

46 47 PMT scheduled for October 14 2003 in Kobe, Japan.

ACTION 2003/10-01

The Chair is to:

- Consolidate all OP input received on the subject of the 3GPP2 release planning guidelines;
- Modify the flow-chart provided by the PMT to bring it in line with the inputs provided by the OPs;
- Circulate the consolidated output via the OP reflector for speedy review by the Organizational Partners;
- Provide the consolidated output to the PMT in preparation for its October 2003 meetings in Kobe, Japan.

ACTION 2003/10-02

The Secretary is to draft correspondence to the 3GPP2 membership via the TSGs noting the approved method in which the trademark status of the term cdma2000 is to be noted in 3GPP2 documents.

ACTION 2003/10-03

The Secretariat is to amend 3GPP2 documents published since registration of the term cdma2000 as a trademark in the USA by replacing any existing footnote text with the newly-approved footnote, and is to return the amended source-file to the editor for future maintenance.

ACTION 2003/10-04

The Secretariat is to distribute, to the OPs, the material prepared by the PMT noting the modifications made to the input provided by the Organizational Partners relative to the revised 3GPP2 publications process. The Organizational Partners are asked to review the material and to provide any comments in preparation for the October meeting of the PMT scheduled for October 14 2003 in Kobe, Japan.

The next meeting of the 3GPP2 Organizational Partners is scheduled to take place in Kobe, Japan on October 21 2003.
