1 During the period of 15-19 June 2009, 3GPP2 TSG-S meetings were held at the Newport Beach  
2 Marriott Hotel in Newport Beach, CA, USA. This document is intended to summarize those

7 Monday 15 June 2009 at 1:38PM local time by TSG-S Chair, Nick Yamasaki (KDDI).

1 **CLOSING PLENARY**

2 The meeting was reconvened on Thursday 18 June 2009 at 1:38 PM local time by TSG-S Chair, Nick  
3 Yamasaki (KDDI).
