2 | support for TIA-856 based handsets. This functionality may be included in A.S0008-A and  
3 | A.S0009-0 publications – the priority is to first complete Cross Technology Paging and QoS. The  
4 | contributing companies plan to support this work item with contributions and invite other  
5 | companies to also contribute to the same.
