4 OPENING PLENARY

6 9:50 AM local time on 11 March 2002 by TSG-C Chair, Jean Alphonse (Lucent).

7 The Chair stated that the objectives for this week included the release of baseline text for
8 cdma2000 Release C.

11 established (66% participation).

29 • Naming of the F-PDCH and F-SPDCCH.
30 • Default Walsh Tables.
31 • F-PDCH interleaving parameters
32 • CQICH traffic to pilot ratios
33 • Physical layer timing of the MS existing control hold (R-PICH,
34 R-CQICH, R-FCH/R-DCCH) and whether it is frame aligned.
35 • Final MAC & Signaling Parameters.
- 36 • Action on the following items has been deferred until the SDO review period (if
37 results show benefit):
- 38 • Should the R-ACKCH and R-CQICH channels be differently
39 distributed between "I" and "Q"?
40 • Optimization of puncturing for the F-SPDCCH. Full verification of

- 28 • Continued review of Stage 1 descriptions and WG1 will incorporate WG2 comments
29 on specific Stage 1s into correspondence to TSG-S by the opening Plenary at the next
30 meeting.
- 31 • Met with WG3 and reached consensus on Cell Selection and Control Hold. A joint
32 conference call will be held on 20 March 2002 to sync up the loose ends with Physical
33 Layer, MAC and Layer 3.

11 meeting for the joint work on spatial channel modeling (see C00-20020311-103D).
12 The Chairs have reached tentative agreement on a number of points:
- 13 • The work will be done by a joint 3GPP/3GPP2 ad hoc group
- 14 • There will be two co-chairs, one from 3GPP and one from 3GPP2
- 15 • The output of the group should be a Technical Report (TR) or text proposals
16 for TRs. Note that 3GPP has an existing TR in 3GPP side, the output of the ad
17 hoc may be one section or annex in the TR. The 3GPP2 ad hoc group has
18 been working on a report.
- 19 • Both link and system modeling will be addressed, though there may be some
20 small differences in system modeling due to the differences in air interfaces.
- 21 • The meetings will roughly alternate between 3GPP and 3GPP2 venues. Due to
22 the different schedules between 3GPP and 3GPP2, it seems difficult to schedule
23 alternating meetings, thus this group may meet on its own. There may also be
24 conference calls. The first meeting (see below) is with 3GPP. It is expected
25 that the group will meet with 3GPP2 in July or August. It is expected that a
26 schedule will be developed by the group.
- 27 • Written meeting summaries will be produced for each meeting.
- 28 Additional details include the following :
- 29 • Subject to confirmation with him, Achilles Kogiantis, chair of the Working
30 Group 3 ad hoc of spatial modeling will serve as the 3GPP2 Co-Chair.
- 31 • The first joint meeting will be in Paris on 10-11 April 2002 (see
32 C00-20020311-103E for the 3GPP meeting invitation - Note that the hotel
33 cutoff date is this Friday)
- 34 • Regarding WG3 meetings in April 2002:
- 35 • Will meet all day Tuesday, Wednesday morning, and Thursday morning. Note
36 that there will not be a Monday afternoon meeting.
