1 During the period of 25-29 August 2008, 3GPP2 TSG-C meetings were held at the Hyatt Regency
2 Vancouver hotel in Vancouver, BC, Canada. This document is intended to summarize those
3 proceedings.

4 5 OPENING PLENARY

6 1. **CALL TO ORDER AND OPENING REMARKS:** The meeting was called to order on
7 Monday 25 August 2008 at 9:39 AM local time by TSG-C Chair, Dennis Gentzler (Alltel).

8 The Chair welcomed everyone to Vancouver. The Chair requested all participants to sign in on
9 the 3GPP2 LAN.

10 2. **ATTENDANCE REGISTRATION AND ROLL CALL:** A roll call of companies indicated
11 that 22 companies included on the list of 27 active quorum members were present (81%
12 participation). Thus, meeting quorum was achieved.

13 The Secretary noted that no proxy statements had been received for this meeting.

14 The Chair summarized the following activities for the week:

- 15 • Monday 5:00-7:30 PM TSG-S Vision AdHoc
- 16 • Tuesday NOON-1:00 PM PMT Host discussions regarding revision of
17 SC.P1002 to codify Multi-part documents revision practice.
18 The Chair requested that the WG1 Chair take the lead for
19 TSG-C on this.
- 20 • Tuesday 4:00-6:00 PM TSG-S WG1 hosted joint TSG discussions
21 regarding Emergency Callback issues. The Chair requested
22 that the WG2 Chair take the lead for TSG-C on this.
- 23 • Wednesday 9:00-11:30 AM TSG-C WG1 hosted discussions for TSG-C
24 workplan issues in the WG3 meeting room.
- 25 • Wednesday NOON-1:00 PM 3GPP2 hosted lunch.
- 26 • Thursday 7:30-9:00 PM Potential start of TSG-C closing Plenary (if needed)

28 3. **INTRODUCTION AND NUMBERING OF CONTRIBUTIONS:** Contributions were loaded
29 onto the 3GPP2 LAN server and listed in the document register (C00-20080825- 000).

30 4. **AGENDA APPROVAL:** The proposed agenda (C00-20080825-001) was presented.

31 **DECISION: The agenda was approved without objection as submitted (C00-20080825-001).**

32 The Chair noted the following meeting objectives for this session:

- 33 • Complete all V&V comment resolutions
- 34 • 3GPP2 Interworking projects
- 35 • 1x/HRPD Enhancements

- 1 • UMB point release and related items have a lower priority
- 2 The Chair noted that WG2 and WG3 will be meeting in Vancouver next month. The Chair
- 3 requested input from WG2 and WG3 Chairs regarding whether or not an interim Plenary
- 4 conference call will be required after that September session.
- 5 5. **ASSIGNMENTS OF CONTRIBUTIONS TO AGENDA ITEMS:** Contributions were
- 6 assigned to agenda items as noted on the agenda.
- 7 6. **APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MEETING SUMMARY:** The summary of the TSG-C meeting
- 8 for July 2008 that was held in Orlando, FL, USA (C00-20080825-002) was presented.
- 9 **DECISION: This meeting summary was approved without objection as submitted (C00-**
- 10 **20080825-002).**
- 11 7. **REVIEW OF OUTSTANDING ACTIONS FROM PREVIOUS MEETING:** The action
- 12 items from the July 2008 face-to-face meeting and interim Plenary conference call were noted as
- 13 follows:
- 14 080721-001 The NTAH Chair will provide a list of actions already submitted by 3GPP2 in
- 15 conjunction with IMT Advanced activities for reference in the TSG-C Report to the SC.
- 16 **DECISION: This action was CLOSED without objection.**
- 17 8. **LIAISON REPORTS:**
- 18 • OP: No contributions or discussion.
- 19 • SC: A Summary of SC/OP meetings for July and OP conference call of 7 August 2008
- 20 (C00-20080825-006) was presented from the 3GPP2 Secretariat with an unofficial
- 21 summary by the TSG-C Secretary as FYI for TSG-C.
- 22 The SC decided that the numbers of meetings would be reduced to nine (9) sessions.
- 23 Regarding requests for SC direction from TSG-C:
- 24 • Although 3GPP2 will not have an IMT Advanced candidate technology by the
- 25 date of the upcoming IMT Advanced Workshop (7 October 2008), the SC agreed
- 26 to support TSG-C participation in that workshop as a means of showcasing
- 27 cdma2000 enhancements.
- 28 • It was noted that the question regarding whether or not 3GPP2 should register as
- 29 an independent evaluator for IMT Advanced is under OP consideration with
- 30 guidance deferred until their next meeting in November. Deadline for registration
- 31 is the end of 2009.
- 32 • The SC decided that work of TDD will continue to be targeted as an update to the
- 33 CDMA MC M.1457-9 submission and not as a new technology submission
- 34 pending final comments from ARIB by the next meeting.
- 35 Regarding 3GPP2 submission of an IMT Advanced candidate technology, the SC
- 36 forwarded the following comments for OP consideration:

- 1 • The revised PPA allows work on IMT Advanced. However, OP direction was
2 solicited on whether or not 3GPP2 “should” submit a candidate technology to
3 IMT Advanced. OP guidance has been differed to their November meeting
- 4 • There should be ongoing discussions with 3GPP.
- 5 • There is no overwhelming support for 3GPP2 filing of a candidate technology for
6 the October 2009 deadline and no support for closing the door on IMT Advanced
7 submissions in the future.

8 The following issues were discussed during the OP conference call on 7 August 2008:

- 9 • Consideration of whether 3GPP2 should register as an independent evaluator for
10 IMT Advanced: All OPs expressed general consensus that 3GPP2 should not
11 register as an independent evaluator for IMT Advanced. Several noted that they
12 plan to register in this capacity. However, final decision on this topic was deferred
13 to the OP meeting for November 2008 in Seoul.
- 14 • Clarification regarding modifications made to the Partnership Project Agreement
15 (PPA) to expand the scope to include work “beyond 3G”: All OPs expressed
16 general consensus that the updated PPA should be interpreted as 3GPP2 “can”
17 work on IMT Advanced but the PPA language does not direct 3GPP2 to do so
18 (can and not a should). However, final decision on this topic was deferred to the
19 OP meeting for November 2008 in Seoul.

20 **ACTION: The ITU AdHoc was remanded an action to draft correspondence to ITU**
21 **indicated the intent of 3GPP2 to make a presentation at the upcoming ITU AdHoc.**

17 3GPP2 input to the ITU Workshop based on agenda and objective information previously
18 provided by ITU. The Chair will discuss the subject of the person who should make the
19 IMT Advanced Workshop presentation on behalf of 3GPP2 with the TSG-C Chair's team
20 this week.

32 **NTAH as FYI.**
- 33 • A WI proposal for HRPD Rev. B Point Release (C00-20080825-032) was presented from
34 Qualcomm, Nortel, and Samsung. **ACTION: This contribution was remanded to**
35 **WG1 for review and action as appropriate.**

- 1 11. **ITU PROCESS/APPROVAL:** Comments on the Input for ITU-R Recommendations M.1580
2 and M.1581 systems (C00-20080825-022) was presented from KDDI, Hitachi, and Kyocera.

12 **of the September 2009 discussions.**
