- During the period of 13-15 February 2001, a meeting of the 3GPP2 TSG-S All IP AdHoc was held at
- 2 the Sheraton San Marcos in Phoenix, AZ. This report is intended to summarize those discussions.
- CALL TO ORDER AND OPENING REMARKS: The meeting was called to order on
   February 2001 at 8:25 AM local time by All IP AdHoc Chair, Mark Lipford (Sprint PCS).
- 5 2. ATTENDANCE REGISTRATION: Attendance was taken using an electronic sign-in sheet that was loaded onto the server. This sign-in sheet indicated approximately 20 persons in attendance.
- 8 3. ADOPTION OF AGENDA: The proposed agenda (S00-ALLIP-20010213-001R2) was presented and approved without objection as submitted.
- 4. ASSIGNMENT OF CONTRIBUTIONS TO AGENDA ITEMS: Contribution numbers were listed in the Document Register (S00-ALLIP-20010213-000R2). Contribution numbers were assigned to agenda items.
- REVIEW/ACCEPTANCE OF PREVIOUS MEETING SUMMARY: The summary of
   January 2001 meeting which was held in San Diego (S00-ALLIP-20010213-002) was
   presented and approved without objection as submitted.
- 16 6. CORRESPONDENCE:

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- E-mail correspondence dated 4 February 2001 regarding the Network and Interop Broadband Wireless Summit (S00-ALLIP-20010213-007) was presented. This was correspondence requesting a speaker to represent 3GPP2 and give an overview of the All IP activities in May 2001. Vice Chair, Mike Dolan (Lucent), has volunteered to do this presentation.
- An overview of the IETF-3GPP2 collaboration strategy that was approved by the 3GPP2 SC (S00-ALLIP-20010213-020) was presented as FYI.
- 7. JOINT MEETINGS FOR NEXT MONTH: There was general discussion on how to plan meeting with the TSGs for the succeeding month and the exact role the adhoc should play in the technical development activities. There was general consensus that these issues must be discussed at the initial joint meetings this week.
- JOINT MEETINGS WITH TSGs: A proposed generic agenda for the joint meetings with
   TSGs (S00-ALLIP-20010213-021R1) was presented and reviewed by the Chair. The
   agenda was approved without objection to be used as the basis of the meetings with TSGs this
   week.
- 9. PROCEDURES: Proposed correspondence to all TSG Chairs regarding the procedure to change the 3GPP2 All-IP Network Architecture (S00-ALLIP-20010213-005) was presented by the Vice Chair. The contribution was approved without objection for transmission as modified by the discussion (S00-ALLIP-20010213-005R2).

#### 1 10. **OLD BUSINESS:** 2 REQUIREMENTS, FEATURES, AND SERVICES 3 The updated All IP Requirements document v1.0.1 4 (S00-ALLIP-20010213-003) was presented and reviewed by the Editor. The 5 changes noted were accepted without objection. However, the Editor was 6 directed to make format corrections including headers and font sizes/styles. 7 The Open Items List v2.0 (S00-ALLIP-20010213-004) was presented as 8 FYI. 9 Proposed requirements for naming and addressing in the IP Multimedia Domain 10 (S00ALLIP-20010213-019) were presented and reviewed by Siemens. 11 These requirements were accepted without objection as modified by the 12 discussion (S00ALLIP-20010213-019R1). 13 Proposed text for requirements 25-35 (S00-ALLIP-20010213-012) was 14 presented by Nokia. This text was left open for consideration in the 15 development of Stage 1 descriptions with redline changes accepted 16 (S00-ALLIP-20010213-012R1). 17 The current IS-664 Feature List (S00-ALLIP-20010213-014) was presented 18 by Sprint PCS. A legend for prioritization of these features was also provided. 19 During the discussion, participants noted that this list was not current. The 20 contributor agreed to revise and resubmit based on a more recent listing of 21 features. 22 Once this list is provided, the group needs to determine which features are 23 mandatory for the All IP network and then to prioritize those mandatory 24 features for Stage 1 development. 25 During this discussion, the group agreed that the features from the IS-664 list which are determined to be mandatory must be included in Release C for the 26 27 legacy domain. The multimedia domain which is specified for Release C must 28 be capable of support all IS-664 mandatory features even if those features 29 themselves are cannot actually be completely specified. 30 Ericsson comments on the Feature Description document (S00-ALLIP-20010213-015) were noted. This contribution was left open pending future 31 32 discussions on feature definitions. 33 **ARCHITECTURE** 34 A proposed clarification of the domain concepts for the continued All IP effort 35 within 3GPP2 (S00-ALLIP-20010213-009R1) was presented by Ericsson. 36 This contribution proposed new descriptions for the legacy and multimedia 37 domains in addition to other information. The definitions of legacy and 38 multimedia domains were adopted without objection as modified by the discussion (S00-ALLIP-20010213-009R2). The balance of the contribution 39

was left open for further discussion.

12		month(s). TSG-N indicated that most of the joint activities would be handled
13		by TSG-N WG2, Stage 2 activities. Since TSG-N sets its meeting schedule
14		one (1) month in advance, TSG-P expressed concerns that this strategy might
15 16		not allow enough flexibility to address all issues. All participants were
16 17		encouraged to use e-mail distribution and conference calls to preview and resolve all contributions in advance of the meeting. The Chairs of the two (2)
18		TSGs would also assist in coordinating the joint meeting schedule.

After some discussion, he group agreed that the following items should be identified to TSG-A in the oint meeting as the near-term priorities for all IP RAN development:

31			A contribution on input to the All IP release and project planning (S00-
32			ALLIP-20010116-008) was presented by Ericsson. This contribution
33 34		_	proposed a number of new work items and system level deliverables. This contribution was left open for consideration at future discussions on the All IP
35			project plan.

A contribution on proposed All IP project actions (S00-ALLIP-20010213-1 2 016) was presented by Lucent. This contribution proposed that the following 3 actions be taken by the adhoc during this month: 4 Develop a draft of the Release C feature list 5 Begin development of Stage 1 descriptions required for All IP 6 List the major All IP Release C features in a draft Project Plan 7 The group agreed that all of these actions were in process based on other 8 discussions and activities at this meeting. 9 A proposal to add the "ii" reference point to the All IP Project Responsibility Matrix between the MS and the Advertising Agent and note TSG-P as being 10 responsible for this interface (S00-ALLIP-20010213-017) was presented by 11 12 Lucent. During the discussion, it was noted that TSG-P and TSG-N have 13 agreed that this reference point should be the responsibility of TSG-N. 14 However, after review of the TSG-P/TSG-N agreement that interface 33 between the MRF and MGW should be the responsibility of TSG-N, the group 15 16 decided that the responsibility should belong to TSG-P. In addition, TSG-C 17 was also noted with consulting responsibility for AGW for QoS issues. This contribution was approved as modified by the discussion (S00-ALLIP-18 19 20010213-017R2). 20 11. **NEW BUSINESS:** 21 A QoS JEDI was held on 14 February 2001 at 10:00 AM. 22 There was substantial concern expressed that this meeting had not been 23 properly communicated to the TSGs. The adhoc agreed to do a better job of 24 promoting these types of activities. 25 A proposed unified framework for QoS support 3GPP2 All IP and legacy 26 networks (S00-ALLIP-20010213-010) was presented by Ericsson. This 27 contribution included a target QoS architecture, proposed terms/definitions, and 28 message flow diagrams indicating how QoS would work. This contribution was 29 adopted without objection. A summary liaison report on this issue will be 30 prepared by the contributor and the Vice Chair for consideration at the closing 31 Plenary. 32 The QoS JEM Output Report from the TSG-S QoS JEM which was held in 33 Kansas City, MO during the period of 24-25 January 2001 (S00-ALLIP-34 20010213-023) was reviewed as FYI. There was some concern that the All 35 IP AdHoc needs to have some input into the QoS activities on the legacy network to insure consistency of approach. The group agreed that this input 36 37 could be made on the Stage 1 description being developed by TSG-S.

The QoS JEDI was adjourned on 14 February 2001 at NOON.

- A liaison from ITU on IMT-2000 management (S00-ALLIP-20010213-006) was presented by Motorola as FYI. However, there were documents referenced in this contribution which were not available for review by the group. Jörg Schmidt (Motorola) took an action to provide the referenced documents at the March 2001 meeting.
  - Proposed correspondence to TSG-N regarding All IP Stage 1 Feature descriptions (S00-ALLIP-20010213-032) was presented. During the process of review, volunteers were solicited for responsibility assignments. All volunteers were requested to have preliminary descriptions of the feature at the next meeting when a Stage 1 template is expected from TSG-S WG1. During the discussion, the group also agreed to restructure the correspondence so it was addressed to all TSGs. The correspondence was approved without object as modified by the discussion (S00-ALLIP-20010213-032R1) for transmission to all TSGs.
