- 1 During the period of 11-14 June 2001, a meeting of 3GPP2 TSG-S was held at the Metropolitan Hotel
- 2 in Vancouver, BC. This report is intended to summarize those discussions.

# 3 **OPENING PLENARY**

4 1. CALL TO ORDER AND OPENING REMARKS: The meeting was called to order on 5 11 June 2001 at 1:30 PM local time by TSG-S Chair, Rich Robinson (Sprint PCS). 6 The Chair welcomed everyone to the 26th meeting of TSG-S and to Vancouver, BC. Each 7 attendee briefly introduced himself to the group. 8 2. ATTENDANCE REGISTRATION AND ROLL CALL: A roll call of TSG-S active 9 companies indicated 14 companies in attendance out of 17 active companies (82% 10 participation). Thus, meeting quorum was achieved. Sign-in of individual attendees was 11 accomplished via electronic sign-in on a file on the server. 12 3. DISTRIBUTION AND NUMBERING OF CONTRIBUTIONS: Contributions were 13 documented in S00-20010611-000R2. All contributions were distributed as soft copy only. 14 4. ADOPTION OF AGENDA: The proposed agenda (S00-20010611-001R3) was reviewed 15 and approved without objection with the addition of missing contribution references (S00-16 20010611-001R4). 28 29 30 31 32		•	PRIORITY ACCESS SERVICE (PAS): NCS (National Communication System) presented an overview of requirements for a Priority Access Service (PAS) system (S00-20010611-009). The initial goal (current request) is to get priority access to a radio channel on a per-call basis. The ultimate goal is to get priority access to an end-to-end connection. Actions requested by NCS included the following:
33			Review and comment on PAS Service Description
34			Include PAS as a QoS requirement
35			• Help brainstorm solutions to achieving FCC 00-242

The current request is for voice services only but NCS ultimately wants to support this 1 2 facility for data services as well. 3 NCS had previously presented this proposal to TR45 and the action was remanded to 4 TR45 WIN task group. The WIN group required NCS to solicit level of interest from 5 system operators. So far, there has been no full buy-in but negotiations are still in 6 process. NCS is even discussing potential business cases for making this type of 7 service available commercially. 8 NCS also indicates their desire to support this service on standard handset devices (i.e., 9 no special facilities - no PACA). This contribution was noted by the TSG as FYI. 10 A contribution entitled "TSG-S: Development of Security Requirements in 3GPP2" 11 • 12 (S00-20010611-007) was presented by QUALCOMM. This contribution 13 recommended the formation of a 3GPP2 group within TSG-S to handle security requirements and architecture while the algorithm development activities are still handled 14 15 by TR45 AHAG. There was substantial discussion on this topic. The Chair formed a 16 Security Planning AdHoc to develop a gameplan to implement this recommendation for consideration by the closing Plenary. Nick Mazzerella (Lucent) agreed to Chair this 17 18 group at a meeting on Thursday AM. 19 10. **OLD BUSINESS:** 20 WG1 ISSUES: A contribution recommending the preparation of a 3GPP2 Stage 1 • 21 document corresponding to N.S0027 Enhanced International Dialing (S00-20010611-22 017) was presented by Hitachi on behalf of six (6) other Japanese company 23 co-contributors. This contribution was remanded to WG1 for review and action as 24 appropriate. KDDI and its co-contributors indicated their intent to provide a draft of 25 the Stage 1 text. 26 • W2 ISSUES: No additional issues were noted. 27 • PMT ISSUES: A contribution entitled "Reinforcement of the current PMT" 28 (S00-20010611-003R1) was presented by KDDI on behalf of six (6) other Japanese 29 company co-contributors. This contribution indicated that these contribution sponsors 30 were not convinced that a PMT function which is separate from TSG-S is required to 31 fulfill the objective of active program management. This contribution proposed that the 32 program management function should be reinforced based on the TSG Coordination AdHoc 33 Report by improving cross-TSG communication, improving work process and introducing a new PMT composition. This contribution was remanded to the PMT for review and 34 35 action as appropriate. 36 ALL IP ADHOC: No report. • 37 • V&V REPORT: No report. 38 UIM ADHOC: No report. •
