- 2 Conference Center Kobe in Kobe, Japan. This document is intended to summarize those
- 3 proceedings.

4 **OPENING PLENARY**

- 51.CALL TO ORDER AND OPENING REMARKS: The meeting was called to order on613 October 2003 at 1:12 PM local time by TSG-S Chair, Richard Robinson (Sprint).
