- 1. CALL TO ORDER AND OPENING REMARKS: The meeting was called to order on 14 February 2005 at 1:40 PM local time by TSG-S Chair, Nick Yamasaki (KDDI). The Chair welcomed the participants to Tokyo, Japan.
- 7 The meeting participants each introduced themselves and were requested to sign-in 8 electronically using the server sign-in facility.
- 9 The Chair read the following statement for the record:

"With a great deal of regret and a very strong sense of loss, it is my duty to officially inform the TSG-S plenary of the passing of TSG-S WG4 Chair, Mike Marcovici (Lucent), on the evening of Wednesday 2 February 2005.

Mike had been ill with pneumonia and a viral infection. He was hospitalized and then released. Upon his return home, he fainted and was forced to return to the hospital. The doctors at Loyola Hospital said he had a torn carotid artery - an artery from the neck to the brain. Mike went into a coma on Monday and, on Wednesday, the doctors advised his wife that Mike had taken a turn for the worse. Eventually, the family was forced to remove life support. Mike passed away at 9:30 PM on Wednesday evening.

For 3GPP2, Mike was initially the Vice Chair of the 3GPP2 Security group (TSG-S WG4) under then Chair, Frank Quick (QUALCOMM), at that group's inception. Mike has served as WG4 Chair since Frank's resignation. In both the Vice Chair and Chair positions, Mike has made a substantial contribution to the operations of 3GPP2 and to the support of all TSGs. He is considered to be a key factor for the success of 3GPP2 and its specifications.

In addition, Mike was also an integral part of the TSG-S Leadership team. In this capacity, he also set the standard for handling cross-TSG development issues.

From a TSG-S perspective, Mike's daily participation to our efforts will be sorely missed and we know that his shoes will be very hard to fill. TSG-S feels honored to have had Mike as a part of our team."


