1 During the period of 16-19 January 2006, 3GPP2 TSG-S meetings were held at the Fairmont  
2 Hotel Vancouver in Vancouver, BC, Canada. This document is intended to summarize those

6 16 January 2006 at 2:05 PM local time by TSG-S Chair, Nick Yamasaki (KDDI).
