TSG-X Plenary Meeting Report March 15 - 19, 2004 Vancouver, BC, Canada

OPENING PLENARY

- Opening plenary called to order March 15 at 8:20am.
- Quorum was achieved. The quorum list is contained in Table 1.
- Meeting Agenda was approved.
- Contributions were identified and placed on the agenda by the Chair.
- February Meeting Summary was approved.
- Lucent is sponsoring team building on Thurs. evening. The activity includes a tour of the Vancouver Art Museum followed by dinner at O'Douls. A sign up sheet was circulated.
- **ACTION ITEM**: The CSN and PSN chairs were reminded to review the OMA Liaison report and indicate any discrepancies with their own records to the closing plenary.

- The report from the SC/OP meeting in Seoul, Korea February 16 and 17, 2004 was reviewed.
 - ACTION ITEM: The action item to respond to the SC regarding the IPR issue questions was remanded to the ERA, CSN, and PSN WGs to review the IPR concerns and draft correspondence to the SC indicating any items that might need a legal review.
 - An editor's lunch was arranged to discuss and review the newly approved Publication Numbering Guidelines.
- The PSN WG requested an Interim Plenary be held before the April meeting to approve X.P0019, the BCMCS Framework, for Review and Freeze. The group determined this recommendation could wait until the April meeting.
- The TSG-X workplan archive document was provided by the editor & updates were approved.

- The updated TSG-X workplan change template was provided by the editor & placed in the stationary folder. WG chairs were reminded to use the template for workplan modifications.
- The TSG-X workplan was approved as provided and remanded to ERA, CSN, and PSN WGs for review and update. It was noted that the new Publication Process terminology was reflected in the current workplan.
- The ANSI-41 status update was provided for information. All are requested to provide updates to D. Crowe.
- The revised TSG-X Editor's Manual was introduced. Modifications were made for consistency with the new Publication Process and clarification of the cdma2000 trademark usage.

CLOSING PLENARY

The CSN and PSN chairs indicated that their reviews of the OMA Liaison status correspondence from Feb. showed no discrepancies. No response was needed.

- CSN's recommendation that X.S0012-0 v2.0 be approved for 15 Day SC Review pending editorial review was approved. Text was provided in TR-45.2 contribution 08. Comments are to be emailed to the editor by March 29.
- CSN's recommendation that the workplan be updated to show 1/31/04 as the actual 15 day SC Review completion date of X.S0010, and that X.S0010 be moved to the Workplan Archive, was approved. It will be moved to archives following the next meeting.

- Correspondence to TSG-A regarding the RPDCH parameter was approved to send.
- Correspondence to TSG-A regarding the new BSN was approved to send as modified.
- Correspondence to TSG-C confirming a joint meeting with TSG-C SWGs 1.3 and 2.5 during the April super meeting was approved to send.
