- **ACTION ITEM**: PSN WG Chair to work with Nadia Bishai and the TR45.2 Chair to determine why the MMS Part 000-A did not get published in TIAand provide an update for the workplan. It was reasserted that a Part 000 should be balloted with each other balloted part.
